The participant, originally from El Salvador, has a strong background in electrical engineering, having graduated as a technician in 2001. Gaining extensive experience in electrical construction and maintenance in both El Salvador and USA. After moving to Australia in 2018, they faced challenges finding stable employment until securing a position as a maintenance electrician assistant in 2024.

Before joining ETAUP, the participant had not sought formal recognition of their overseas qualifications. They learned about the program through the Department of Education and the ETU. They applied because they viewed it as a secure and legally compliant pathway into the Australian electrical industry.

The participant finds ETAUP highly beneficial. ETAUP offers clear educational guidelines aligned with Australian standards, allowing participants to learn and apply new knowledge effectively. The structured duration of the program provides ample time to assimilate and practice these standards in a work setting. The participant particularly values the extensive support and guidance provided throughout the process.

Through ETAUP, they are gaining the essential experience and knowledge required to excel under Australian electrical standards. Looking ahead, they plan to continue advancing their career by pursuing further education and training in the electrical field.
